- \Rightarrow Run the coffee bar
- Become a peer educator / trainer
- Be part of a members' committee / project steering group
- Support and motivate others
- ☆ Promote equal opportunities
- ☆ Fundraise for local initiatives
- Assist your youth worker
- ☆ Help plan the unit / club / project programme
- \Rightarrow Organise activities and events
- ☆ Welcome and mentor new members
- \Rightarrow Be part of an interview panel
- Be a voice for young people in your area and Somerset
- ☆ Feed in views or become a part of UK Youth Parliament
- Consult other young people on various issues and feed those issues to key adult figures who can make a difference
- Sit on steering groups to represent local young people's views on issues that affect them or are important to them
- Develop solutions for local need e.g. helping to set up a junior youth club where there is no provision
- \Rightarrow Take part in additional training to keep your skills up to date
