

Icebreakers

Who am I?

Group size: Any size group

Resources needed: • Labels or post-it notes

Instructions:

- Prepare a self-adhesive label or post-it note for each young person in your group. Write the name of a famous person on each one – this can be a historical character, sportsperson, musician, TV personality etc. Have a good mix of male and female names.
- Ask the young people to sit in a circle. Keep names hidden and stick a label or post-it on the forehead of everyone in the group.
- Each young person gets to ask a question about their character to try and guess who they are. Questions can only have a yes or no answer. Go around the circle and each young person gets to ask a question in turn.
- Keep playing until everyone has guessed who they are, or you can set a time limit for the game.
