The UK Shared Prosperity Fund (SPF) invested in places to support people. In Somerset, funding gave us space to pilot new projects and strengthen our support enabling Somerset's charity and community sector to grow and keep growing.

At the outset we commissioned evidence-led research, you can read the full [State of the Sector report here](#). Over the past two years, we've helped local groups build skills, confidence, leadership and practical know-how. We've supported organisations to share experience and create connections to make community-led action possible. And we've built systems so everyone can access reliable data, platforms to connect, chat and support each other, benefitting Somerset long after the SPF funding ends.

# Birchfield, Yeovil: A Community Leading the Way

In Birchfield local people are showing what's possible when they have the right support to back their ideas. By spending time locally and building real relationships, our team helped residents, schools, and local services to come together to create the Birchfield Action Group (BAG). Everyone is welcome to listen, make suggestions, share ideas and find ways to get things done.

And they've got a lot done. From a volunteer-led café and a school uniform rail to family dog shows and a new nature trail, Birchfield is brimming with activity. Our community organisers made sure they were there to guide, but it was residents running the projects and building their skills to benefit their neighbours for years to come.

# Westfield, Yeovil: A Place to Grow

Once an overgrown eyesore, the Westfield Community Garden is now a thriving outdoor space the whole community is proud to visit. Spark Somerset supported Westfield Community Association to recruit volunteers, help organise events with the team and make ideas happen.

Today, it's an award-winning space where generations come together, from the local Brownie group to residents in their 90s. With its outdoor gym equipment, accessible paths, and quiet corners for a chat, the garden has become a little oasis for the neighbourhood. Most importantly, it's run by local volunteers using and learning skills to keep it growing for years to come.

# Somerset Youth Theatre: Create Change

Somerset Youth Theatre (SYT) was created so local young people had a place to belong. Somewhere they could grow in confidence and find connection through creativity. As SYT began to grow, founder and CEO Selina found herself leading not just a project, but a team and an organisation. She joined the Leadership Bootcamp, which gave her the tools and clarity to lead SYT and understand her role as a leader. The difference was immediate.

Today, SYT is stronger, more grounded, and better placed to support the young people who rely on it.

# Stand Against Violence: Confidence, Capacity and Leadership Built to Last

When Stand Against Violence (SAV) reached a pivotal moment, Spark's Leadership Bootcamp gave Operational Manager Aimee Mckean the tools and confidence she needed to steady the organisation and lead it forward. With staff numbers low and pressures high, attending ten weeks of training felt like a risk. But it became the turning point.

# This Living Place: Growing Skills, Confidence and Rural Futures

Two years ago Laura founded This Living Place driven by her passion for Somerset's land and communities. But setting up an organisation is daunting. From legal structures to funding, the pressure of getting it right is real. For Laura meeting Spark Somerset changed that and gave her confidence.

With Spark's support, Laura shaped a clear strategy, identified the right funders and secured £45,000 at short notice to launch a pilot supporting women landworkers and creating a new rural role for a young person. Working with Off Grid Organics, Skool Beanz and This Living Place this extra pair of hands strengthens local food production, and supports our local community to have increased access to healthy, nutritious food.

## The Insights Hub



**The Insights Hub** helps organisations across Somerset understand community needs, show the difference they make, and build stronger cases for support. Sharing information openly helps us plan better, work together more easily, and speak with a clearer, collective voice about what our communities need.

Hosted by Spark Somerset, the Insights Hub brings together local data, sector evidence, stories, and research in one place. It gives organisations a simple way to explore neighbourhood, county and national data, demonstrate impact, and share their own impact.

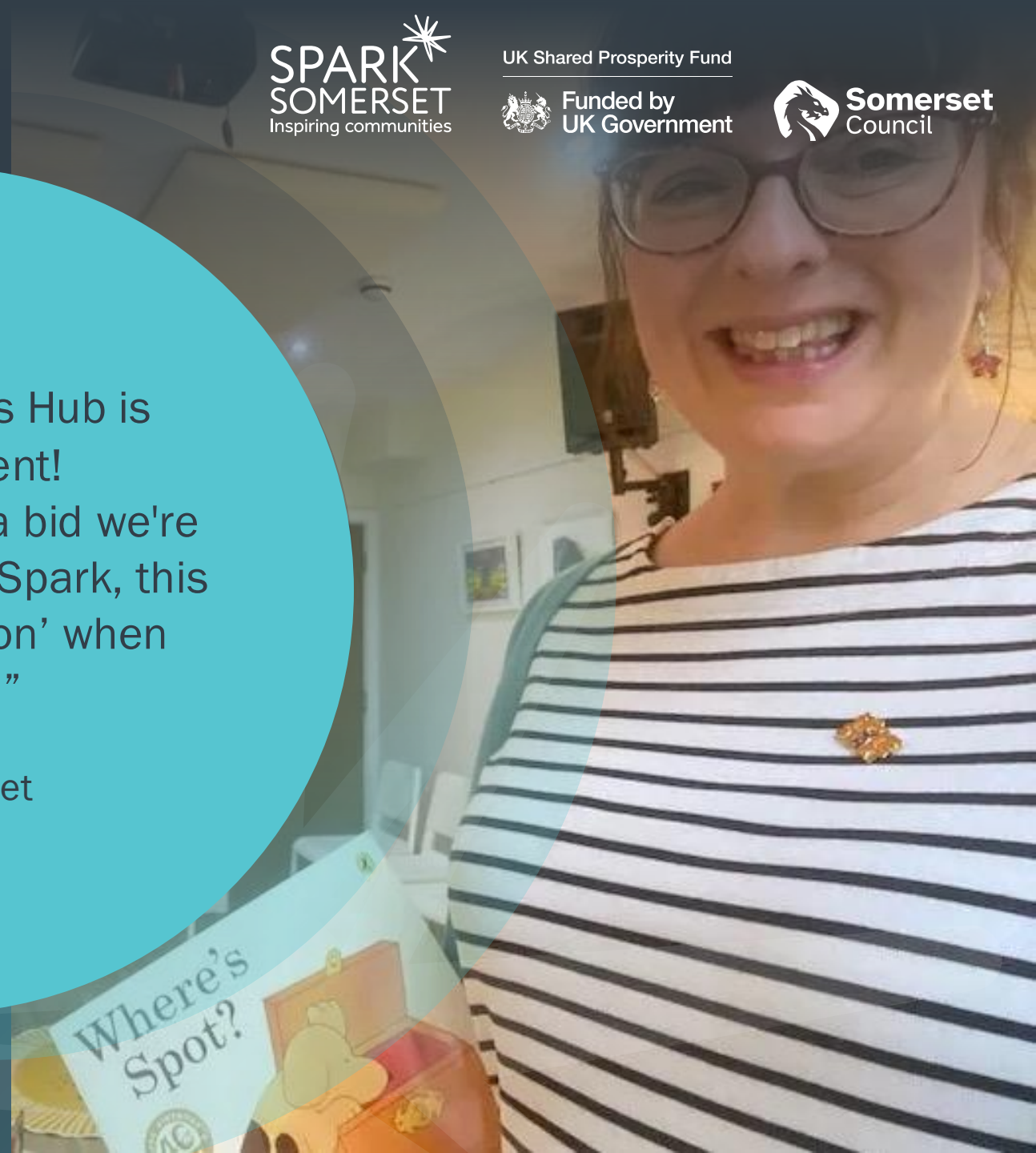

# ShareSpace

ShareSpace is an online peer-to-peer platform helping colleagues across Somerset's charity and community sector stay connected and collaborate. People can share updates, ask questions, link into Spark forums and networks, and access useful resources in one place.

Over 200 external users joined our ShareSpace platform, and the new streamlined site is now live, making it easier for everyone to exchange advice, signpost each other to support, and stay connected between gatherings.





# SkillShare

SkillShare helps charities and community groups access the kind of practical support that makes a real difference at key moments. Matching organisations for one-off advice sessions or longer mentoring, the programme gives participants space to step back, build confidence, and tackle challenges with support. Organisations report gaining new skills, accessing expertise they couldn't afford, and growing in confidence as leaders.

For Prickles Hedgehog Rescue, this meant being matched with Nik Harwood from Young Somerset. Watch the video to see how together they explored fundraising, planning, culture and sustainability and the impact on both organisations.
